

At the primary level, the Teacher in charge listens to the problem in detail. If it is an academic matter, the faculty member of the concerned subject is consulted to sort out the case. If the situation demands, the Teacher in charge will also contact the parent/guardian/ hostel warden. The Teacher In charge refers unresolved cases to the HOD. The two members can avail the services of the Student Welfare Officer if needed. At The appellate level, the Principal and Vice Principal will redress all the unresolved cases in consultation with the College Council and the Director
